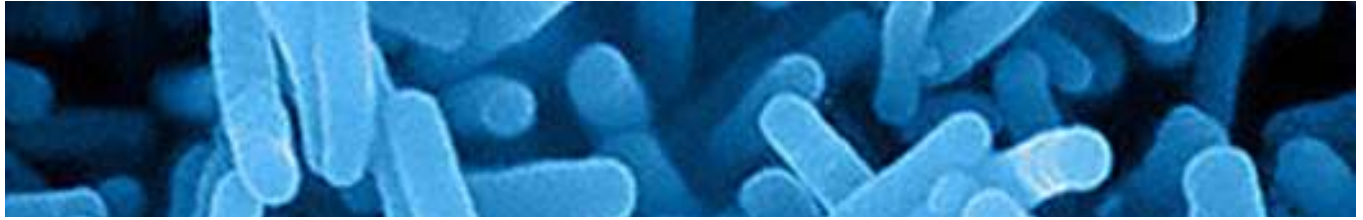
Description
